The Bible



To help you understand the Bible and its message to you, the following major points are important:

- 1. The Bible is not just one book, but a library of 66 books, all of which form the basis of our judgement by God. (Revelation 20:12)
- 2. The Bible was written by about 40 different men over a period of 1600 years. (Moses: 1500 B.C. John: 96 A.D.). It was written in two major languages.
- 3. The Bible is inspired by God. (2 Timothy 3:16). God moved the writers of it to write what He wanted. (1 Peter 1:21).
- 4. All or part of the Bible has been translated into over 1200 languages and dialects. It remains the number one best seller of all time.
- **5. The Bible is indestructible.** "Heaven and earth shall pass away, but My words shall not pass away." (Matthew 24:35)
- 6. The Bible's claim to inspiration can be verified by various kinds of evidence:

A. It is historically accurate.

- B. It has a unified message.
- C. It contains scientific foreknowledge.
- D. It is prophetically accurate.
- 7. The Bible is all complete. We are not to add to it or take away from it. (See 2 Timothy 3:16; Deuteronomy 22:19-20). The teachings of men are not to supersede it. (See Matthew 15:8-9; 2 John 9).
